## How did we get started?



Hope Inn Christ has been founded by individuals who are volunteers at the Gainesville TYC unit. Many of these youth there have no place to go when they are released at 19 years of age. This is when Hope Inn Christ will step in to guide and direct these youth who are committed to living Christian lives.

## The Program

Our program is solely for those young men who want to change their lives and live for Christ. They will be selected from young men that have filled out an application to be a part of our program. They must be willing to attend bible study and prayer groups in the home and a church of their choice. Youth will not be allowed to work the first month, spending this time becoming grounded in the Bible and committed to prayer at our aftercare home. During this time they will be taught how to apply and interview for jobs, learn new life skills, budget their finances and discover foundational Bible truths while in residency at our home. Each resident will be required to tithe, put money in savings each month and pay a monthly service fee covering the expense of their room, food, transportation, etc. This fee will not exceed than \$125.00 per week.

## The Home

We are providing an aftercare home which is located in Wise County.

This facility is a 5,400 square-foot home sitting on 17.7 acres where house parents will reside with the young men to form a Christian family.

We are utilizing our volunteers who currently mentor these youth at TYC to show Christ's love to the young men and to help them to have hope in Christ.

Hope in Christ is what needs to be instilled in the young men leaving Texas Youth Commission (TYC) facilities.



TYC is the state's juvenile corrections agency where youth are placed in TYC by juvenile court judges for felony-level offenses committed when they were at least age 10 and less than 17 years old.
